The Toy bakkie was built by Makita salesperson Jan Reyneke, from scratch, doing some cunning alterations including, making the appearance of a grill using bits of black cable ties and the bull bars made from wardrobe hangers. Jan used the Makita MLT100 Table Saw to cut everything on the toy van to size. For the detail work, he used the BJV180ZK Cordless 18V LXT Jig Saw which provided him with higher accuracy. Jan routed the wheel archers with the Makita RP0900 Router and sanded the van with the 9031 belt sander which is optimum for use in close quarters and on irregular surfaces. The AF505 Pneumatic Nailer was used for all nailing and the HG551VK Heat Gun was used for melting the hangers to shape. Unfortunately, the van will not be in stores for Christmas, but a great result all round.


